

2017 ROBERT HEMENWAY PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD

Award Description

The Dole Institute of Politics established the Robert Hemenway Public Service Award in May of 2009 in honor of the 16th Chancellor of the University of Kansas upon his retirement.

The \$1000 award is given annually to a junior student who has demonstrated a commitment to making a difference for KU students and furthering the idea of service on campus and within the community; the overriding criterion for this award is commitment to public service with demonstrated leadership.

Eligibility for Award

- ◆ Junior status Spring 2017 Semester
- ◆ At least one year to complete at the University of Kansas
- ◆ Must be enrolled as a full time University of Kansas undergraduate student during the 2017-2018 academic year
- ◆ Completed Application and 250 word essay required
