



# 2018 ROBERT HEMENWAY PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD

## Award:

- ♦ The selected recipient of the Robert Hemenway Public Service Award will receive \$1,000 in the fall of 2018.

## Award Description:

The Dole Institute of Politics established the Robert Hemenway Public Service Award in May of 2009 in honor of the 16<sup>th</sup> Chancellor of the University of Kansas upon his retirement. The award is given annually to a junior student who has demonstrated a commitment to making a difference for KU students, and furthering the idea of service on campus and within the community; the overriding criterion for this award is commitment to public service, with demonstrated leadership. There is no GPA requirement. **This award goes to a high profile student leader, respected by peers, who is concerned with strengthening civic life at the University of Kansas.**

## Eligibility for Award

- ♦ Junior status Spring 2018, at least one year to complete at the University of Kansas
- ♦ Applicants must be enrolled as a full time University of Kansas undergraduate student during the 2018-2019 academic year
- ♦ Completed Application and short essay (250 words) required
