Award:

- ◆ The selected recipient of the Robert Hemenway Public Service Award will receive \$1,000 in the fall of 2020.

Award Description:

The Dole Institute of Politics established the Robert Hemenway Public Service Award in May of 2009 in honor of the 16th Chancellor of the University of Kansas upon his retirement. The award is given annually to a KU junior student who has demonstrated a commitment to making a difference for KU students, and furthering the idea of service on campus and within the community; the overriding criterion for this award is commitment to public service, with demonstrated leadership. **This award goes to a student leader, respected by peers, who is concerned with strengthening civic life at the University of Kansas.**

Eligibility for Award

- ◆ Junior status Spring 2020, at least one year to complete at the University of Kansas
- ◆ Applicants must be enrolled as a full time University of Kansas undergraduate student during the 2020-2021 academic year
- ◆ Completed Application and 250 word essay required
